Zoo Admission for School Groups

- \$8.00 per student (*no personal checks from students*)
- Teachers receive FREE admission.
- One FREE adult chaperone admission per every 10 students is required.
- Payment is collected at admission time. We accept cash, school check, or credit card. (*No personal checks or purchase orders*)

Bus Parking Buses will park in the front parking lot. If parking lot is full, park in the next lot located first driveway past park on the right hand side. *Bus Drivers receive FREE admission.*

Note to Groups with Disabilities We are partially wheelchair accessible. The zoo is on natural terrain, which means there are slight inclines, gravel, sand, and grass to manage. **Wildwood Wildlife Park does not have wheelchair rentals.** All persons entering with the group will include 1:1 chaperone to aide the person.

Educational Program

Book your educational program time when scheduling your field trip reservation. Allow 20-25 minutes.

Educational Center

Filled with amazing interactive activities. You'll peer into the world of honeybees and witness the bees performing their specialized duties of producing honey. Microscopes with insect identification and educational tables including: skulls, furs, and artifacts. There are also exhibits with birds, lizards, frogs, scorpions and snakes. Students will find opportunities to learn in every corner of the center.

Dino Dig

An interactive excavation complete with tools for the children to use to uncover dinosaur bones.

Special Animal Treats

Students are allowed to hand feed "Critter Food" to goats, sheep, deer, aoudads, & camel. "Critter Food" can be purchased in the gift shop. "Bear Juice" can be purchased by bear exhibit. There are also feed machines located throughout the park.

Wild Den Gift Shop

Please allow plenty of time to shop, an hour before your scheduled departure time is suggested. Chaperones are required with students. Food and beverages are prohibited.

Giraffe & Parakeet Encounters

You get up close and personal with one of the largest and tallest mammals in the world. When the giraffe leans down to nibble out of your hand or steal a kiss from you. Walk through the aviary offering a feed stick to parakeets and you will have them eating right out of your hand or landing on your head or shoulders just to say "Hi".

Safari TRAM Ride (25-30 minute ride)

Ride the TRAM with a narrated journey winding through the safari seeing a diverse group of animals including: Eland, Wildebeest, Big Horn Sheep, Dall Sheep, Addax, Nilgai, Kudu, Nyala, Ostrich, Scimitar Oryx, Emu, Beisa Oryx, and Thomson's Gazelle.

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLS TOURING WILDWOOD WILDLIFE PARK

1. Once you arrive at the Zoo, we ask only the teacher to check in with the gift shop attendant. The rest of the school group will gather outside by the big gray entrance doors to the right of the main entrance. Please have the exact count of the number of children and adults in the group. Once the group is checked in and payment is received, a Wildwood Staff member will address the group on Zoo Safety Rules. At the conclusion of the talk the group will be escorted into the park.
2. Please arrange one chaperone for every ten students. The chaperone's most important duty is to keep your students with you at all times. Teachers and chaperones will be held responsible for student conduct at the park.
3. Please consider issuing name tags to easily identify students. Make sure students know their chaperone's name in the event they get separated.
4. Talk about what to do in case of an emergency. Students are encouraged to ask for assistance from anyone wearing a Zoo Staff Shirt, or at the Gift Shop.
5. Picnic areas are open to all schools and the public on a first come basis. Because picnic space is limited schools taking Wildwood Lunch Special will use tables closest to the snack stand areas. Schools/Groups may re-enter the zoo after enjoying their lunch in the picnic areas.

FIRST AID: Basic first aid is available in the Gift Shop. For students with medical conditions or with severe allergic reactions, we recommend you bring your first aid kit and staff to assist their needs.

SAFETY OF STUDENTS AND ANIMALS

1. Our zoo is a peaceful haven for animals and people alike, loud noises and running are upsetting to everyone. We ask that students do not chase birds, deer or tap on the glass in the reptile building. Please treat the animals with the respect they deserve. Remember this is their home.
2. Please make sure the students know not to feed the animals or throw anything into their habitats. Throwing objects into the exhibits is cause for expulsion from the zoo.
3. Stay on designated pathways, keep off rocks, do not cross or reach over guard rail fences. The exhibits are designed to protect both you and our animals.
4. Remind the students they need to be aware of how their behavior affects each other, the animals, and the other visitors.
 - Must stay with assigned chaperones. No student can wander the zoo on their own.
 - Always walk. No Running, No Yelling!
 - Place trash in proper containers.
 - Keep your hands, body and objects away from animals and their enclosures.
 - DON'T pick plants or flowers.
 - Be courteous and respectful of other visitors.



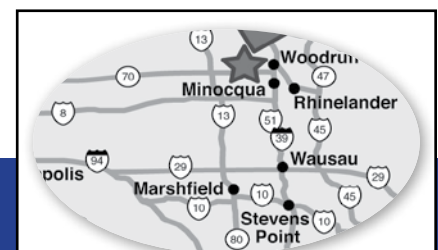
SOME POINTERS TO ENHANCE YOUR SCHOOL VISIT TO THE ZOO
